Awards

Queens will receive a crown, monogrammed banner, flowers, platter, t-shirt & goody bag. Teen and Miss Divisions will receive a platter for Best Interview. All contestants will receive a platter. Miss Queen will receive a \$500 scholarship (check made payable to the college or trade school of her choice upon completion of her contract), custom Battle of Pleasant Hill crown, train, mantle, scepter, and formal banner all to be returned to the BOPH committee, monogrammed banner, flowers, and platter.

She will be required to attend the Louisiana Association of Fairs and Festivals Queen of Queen's pageant in Baton Rouge for 2021, where she will receive a paid entry.

Special Awards

Peoples Choice: Each ticket will be \$1 and be available for purchase an hour before pageant begins. Peoples Choice winner will receive a platter, goody bag, and Battle of Pleasant Hill t-shirt.

Installing Ceremony of Miss Battle

The 2020 Miss Battle will be announced at the pageant. She will be officially crowned and begin her reign during the opening ceremonies of the Battle of Pleasant Hill on Sunday, April 5, 2020, at 1:00 pm.

Rules and General Information

-Photogenic pictures will not be accepted after deadline March 22, 2020 (NO LATE ENTIRES ACCEPTED). One picture only. No larger than an 8x10. No frames. Picture may be black and white or color. Picture can be a professional picture, but NO GLITZ photos. Please include child's name and division on the back.

Teen & Miss Contestants will compete the morning of March 28, 2020 in in. Costume & On-stage introduction will begin at 3:00pm. Evening gown will be at the end of the pageant after Jr. Miss Costume.

-Miss contestants must be 17 years of age and no older than 23 years of age as of Jan 1, 2021. She must be a natural born female and a resident of Louisiana. Teen and Miss Queens will be required to sign a contract after being crowned, and cannot hold any titles aside from Teen/Miss Battle of Pleasant Hill. Miss Contestants must all attend the BOPH Tea.
